Expect tunes from Duke Ellington, Thelonious Monk, Horace Silver, Miles Davis, Nat King Cole, and Dave Brubeck. Brazilian bossa nova and sambas of Antonio Carlos Jobim, Dori Caymmi, Joao Bosco, and Ivan Lins complete his play list. Justin Allison leads the trio, which also includes drummer Allan Finney and Mark Simon on bass.

KATHY MORROW TRIO

Kathy Morrow has been singing and playing the piano in the Vail Valley for the last 18 years, after traveling and performing in Europe, Asia and parts of the Middle East. Her unique energy, vocal range and musical sense are appreciated by all those who experience her performances. Cam Miller, The American Rag, said, "She's Kathy Morrow, a splendid vocalist, who can get up close to a ballad and then sprint through a scat chorus with amazing spirit and enthusiasm."
